Homework Policy

Students will receive spelling homework every night. Besides spelling, students will receive ELA, MATH, SCI, or SS homework during the week. Students will also have to complete 15-20 minutes of reading each night and log it. At the end of the week, students complete a reading map of one of their favorite stories that they read and turn it in as a part of their Reading Log grade. Parents are expected to check their child's homework each night, make notes of areas they struggled with, and sign their reading logs daily. For each day homework is late, 5 points are taken off on the database. Students are encouraged to complete homework daily and even if it is late they will receive partial credit.

Grading Policy

Grades are as followed in the First Grade:
90-100 E for "Exceeds"
80-90 P for "Proficient"
70-80 I for "In progress towards achieving"
Below 69 is an N for "Needs improvement"
