

## *Grading*

How our grading system in Kindergarten works. KT vs KG are they on the same grading scale. How to determine who gets a E, P, I, or an N?

There are a few factors to take into consideration when deciding on a final letter grade. Average out all the grades for each subject. E- 90-100, P- 80-89, I- 70-79 N- Anything below a 70. The subject is then broken down to a standard.

How can you exceed a standard? If the child is proficient and gets the standard then a P is given. You cannot exceed a standard (Ex: write first and last name). If the child is struggling with a standard, use an 'I' for in progress towards achievement or if they aren't near improving then give a 'N' for needs development. This way the parents are made aware of what areas to work on.

If a child is struggling with grades or you notice a standard/area the child needs help on, reach out to the parent and make them aware. Send home extra resources/materials to work on so the child can work towards being successful in that area/standard. Tutoring is also available.
